

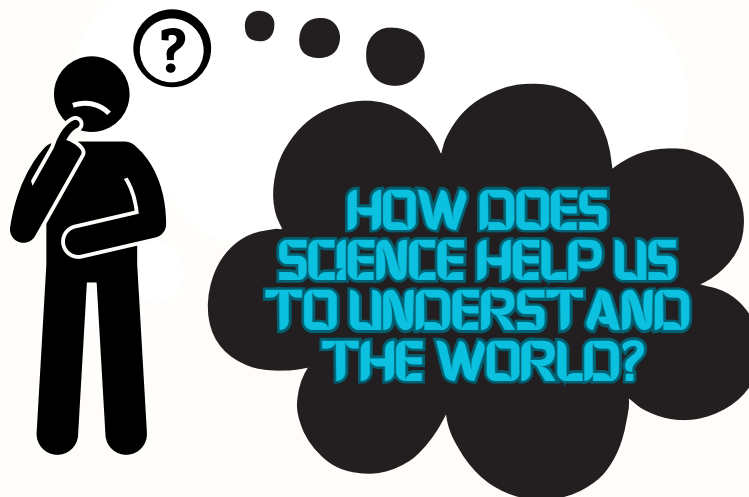

This term is going to be a big change for students, particularly those who have started a new school.

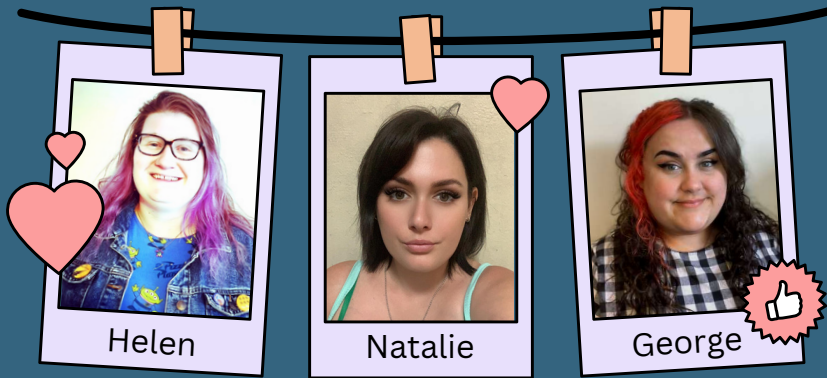
Each student will now have a communication book going home every day so we can have constant communication between home and school. Please spend some time taking a look at what has been written each day.
