Layton became Nelson's member of Parliament - which was announced in assembly by head teacher Sally.

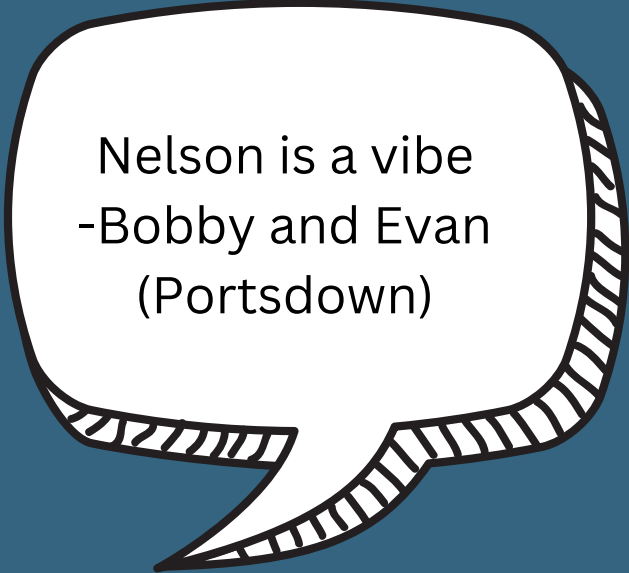
The only person in Nelson that didn't vote for Layton was...Layton!
