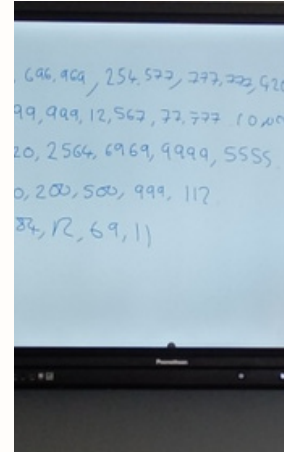
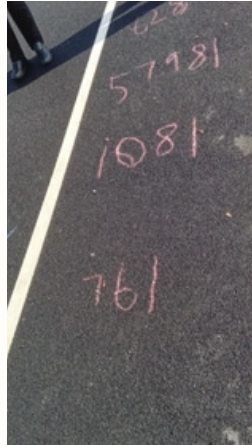
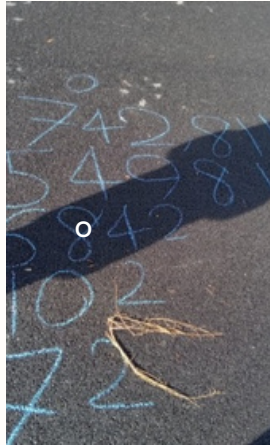
Our Big Focus: 'Please Sir'

I think it's safe to say we have had an extremely busy first few weeks back from half term. Langstone have been creating Kimmy Cantrell inspired masks which look fantastic. We have started to focus on our new topic of 'Please sir'. In this topic we are going to be looking at the Victorians and how they shaped the society and world that we live in today. As a class we are looking forward to our trip to the RNLI and learning about the different boats that they have and how to be safe in the water.

As the term progresses we are going to be making our Christmas stall tie dyed tote bags that will be for sale. In maths we have been looking at 6 digit numbers and place value. We have started to grow our own crystals in science and are excited to see how these grow and change with time.
