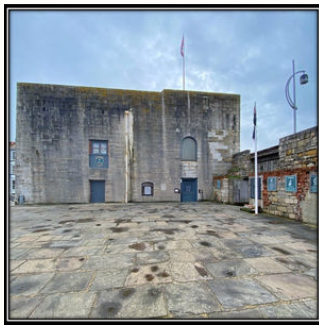

Our Big Questions

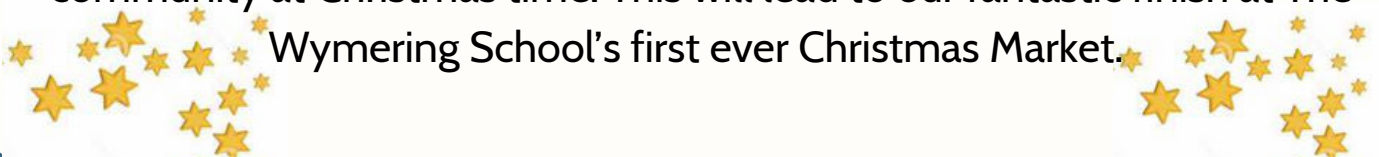
Where do I belong in the world?



This half term, Square Tower's project is 'Around the World'. In the project, pupils will learn the key terminology to describe locations and will look at the physical geographical features of these places. Pupils will learn about what life is like for people in different parts of the world and immerse themselves into the sights, sounds and tastes of different places.

Pupils will be able to listen to the music, learn about the landmarks, appreciate the art and culture and taste foods from the places they explore in the project. They will make comparisons between various cities across the world and look at the climate in each city.

Pupils will focus in on the part of the world that they live in and the communities that they belong to. In the last week of term, pupils will explore the different ways that Christmas is celebrated around the world. They will also consider how they can have a positive impact in their local community at Christmas time. This will lead to our fantastic finish at The Wymering School's first ever Christmas Market.
