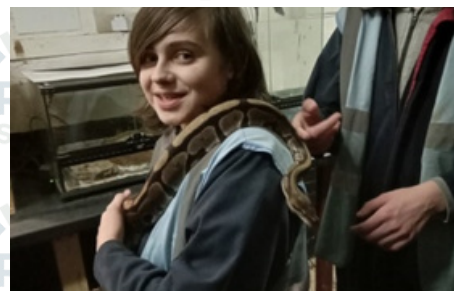


Learning this week.....

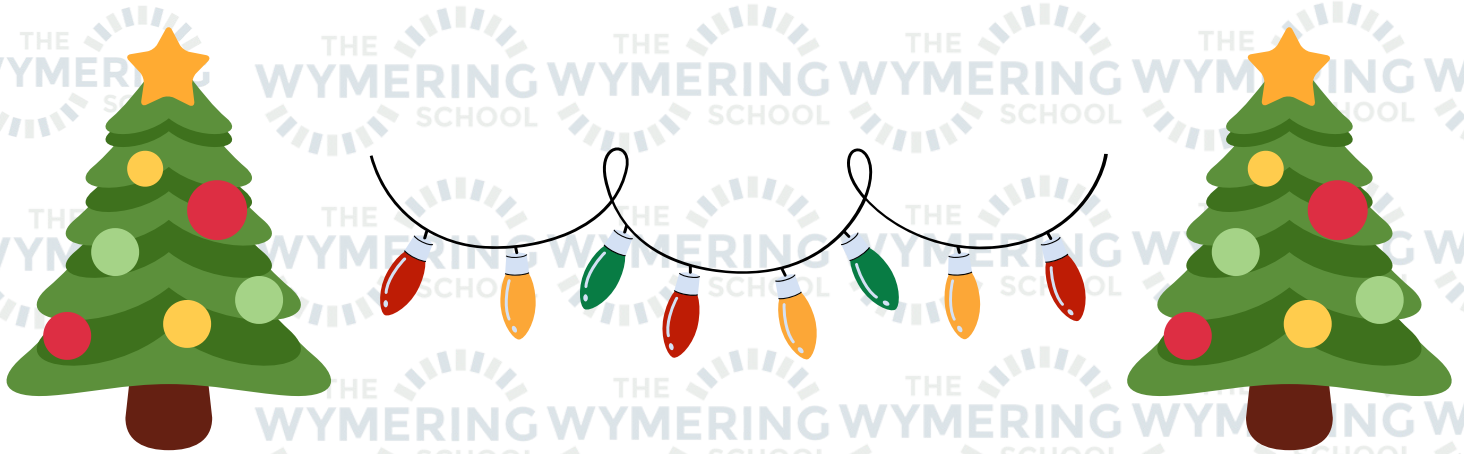
