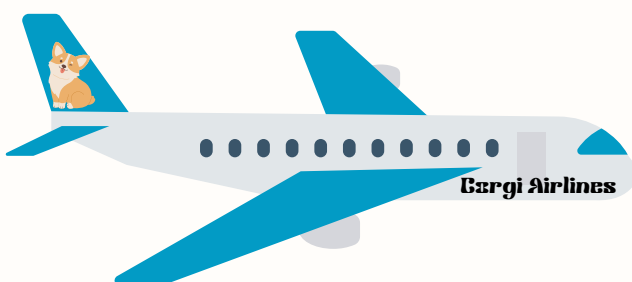
This half term in Dockyard Class
