- **A breaktime snack.** Some of our pupils get hungry before lunchtime so please do feel free to send a breaktime snack for them to have in the morning.

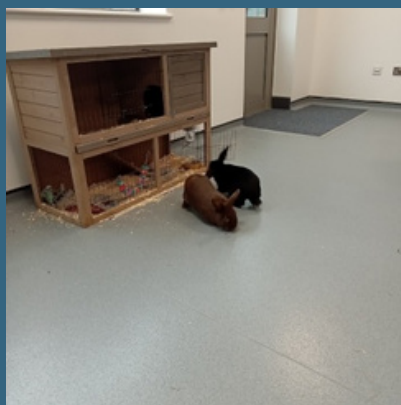


This is Jodie she has now joined
