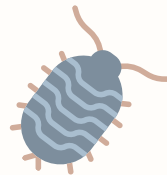


This half term in Trafalgar Class!

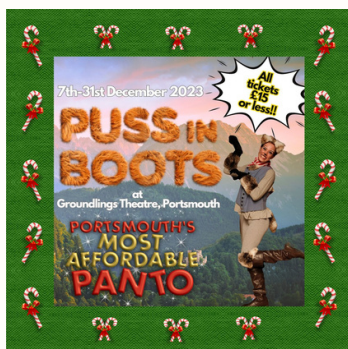
Christmas Holiday Ideas

We have welcomed Danny into our class and we really look forward to getting to know him better and learning lots about his special interests.



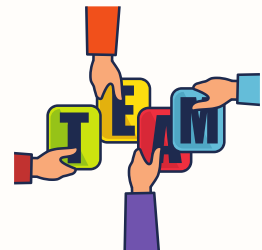
Meet the Team
