## Our Big Focus: 'Myths and Legends'

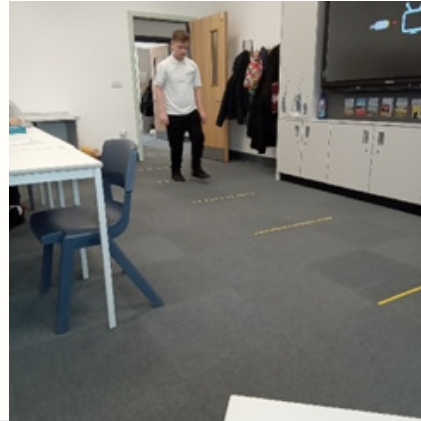

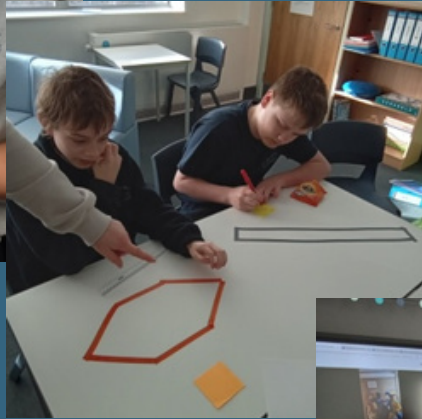
As a class we hope that you have a wonderful half term break.
