This build took us all week and we cant wait to use our amazing outside space and for the rest of the school to enjoy this space.



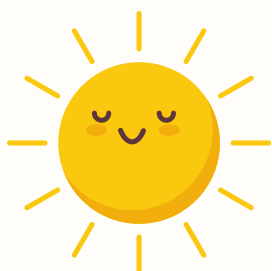
Summer is here
