What is going on in Victorious this half term?

After a busy spring term, we are not slowing down! We are busy as ever in Victorious class and across key stage 4.

The theme for this term is to look forward to our futures and engage in visits to colleges to enable students in making their choices for college, apprenticeships or anything else that they decide to do.
