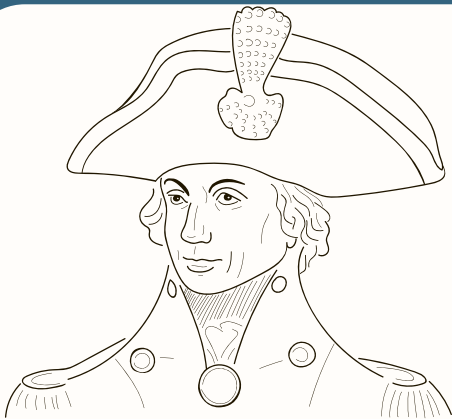

This half term in Nelson

Our Big Question

We are excited to have launched our new topic with the class, 'Whose Earth Is it Anyway?' which looks at taking responsibility for the health and future of our planet. We have also welcomed new TA Holly into team Nelson this half term.

Our Learning Objectives:

In Science and in Geography, we will be studying climate change, renewable energy and the effects of pollution and climate change on wildlife and on humans.

To tie our English lessons to this topic, we will be studying the art of persuasion. The boys really focused in our lesson on rhetorical devices, came up with some fantastic slogans around climate change and tried to persuade the teachers using their new skills.

In Art and Design we will be looking at using recycled materials, culminating in our recycled fashion show at the end of term. More details to follow on this but we would love for you to join us on 18th Dec for this as our 'Fantastic finish' to the unit.

In Maths this half term we will be focusing on multiplication (including decimals), solving written word problems and conversion of measurements (km to m and cm etc.)

As well as our planet-saving curriculum focus, our music lessons in 'Rock Steady' will continue up until Christmas as well as our studies in PE, BTEC Home Cooking, Mental Health and Wellbeing and Life Skills. In PSHE we are looking at the difference between legal and illegal drugs and the issues surrounding them.
