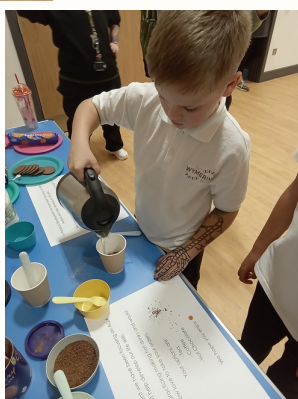

In Lifeskill lessons children have learnt about internet safety and what information is safe to share online.

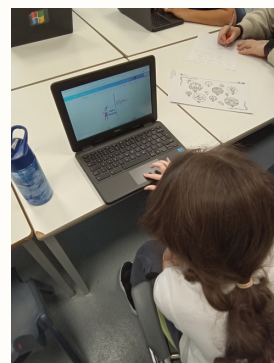
In our mental health and wellbeing lessons this half term we have learnt to recognise that anyone can experience mental ill health. That mental health, just like physical health, is part of daily life.



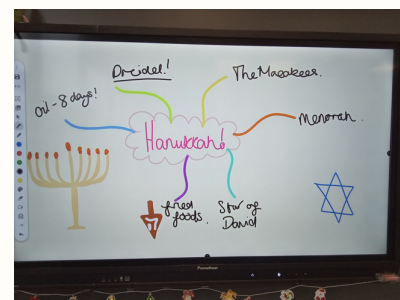
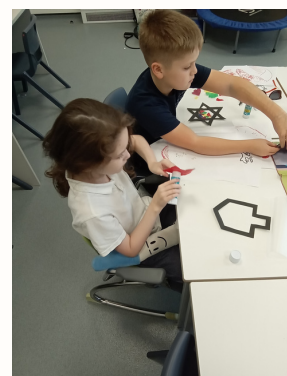

We enjoyed making our Christmas Market items!



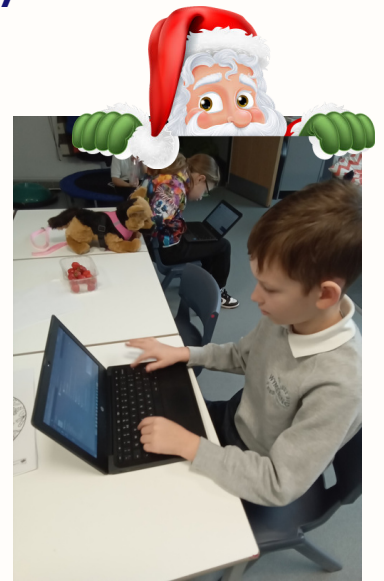
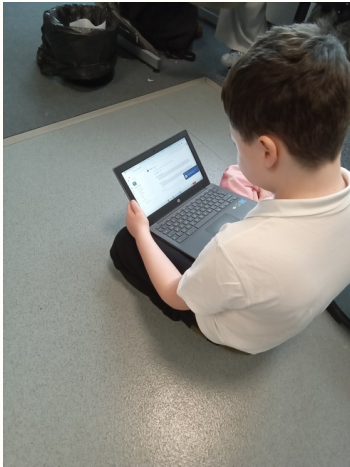
**We had our second Cultural Awareness day this half-term.
