Change of clothes

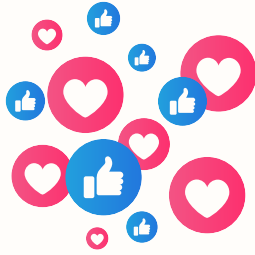


From everyone in Tenth Hole class we hope you have a wonderful Christmas and you all stay safe.
