There are lots of afterschool clubs starting this term so please keep a look out in your emails and letters the students bring home, if you have any questions please feel free to email the school and ask for more details.

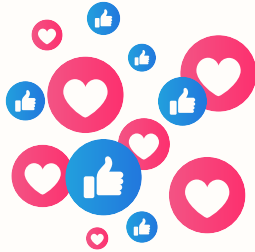
Clubs we have planned are Football club, Warhammer club and trampoline club
