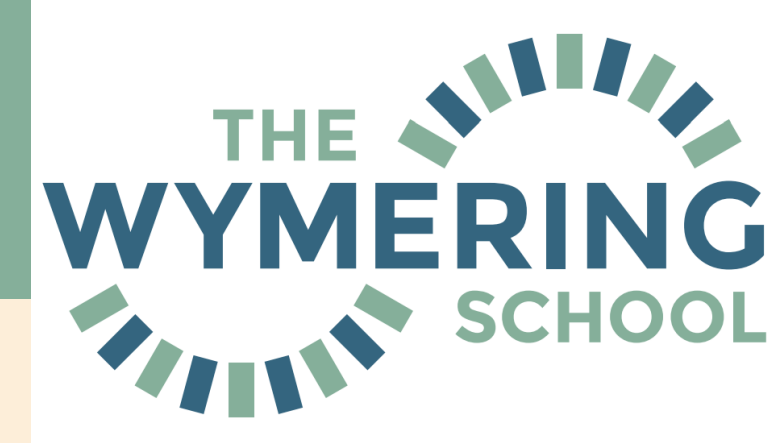
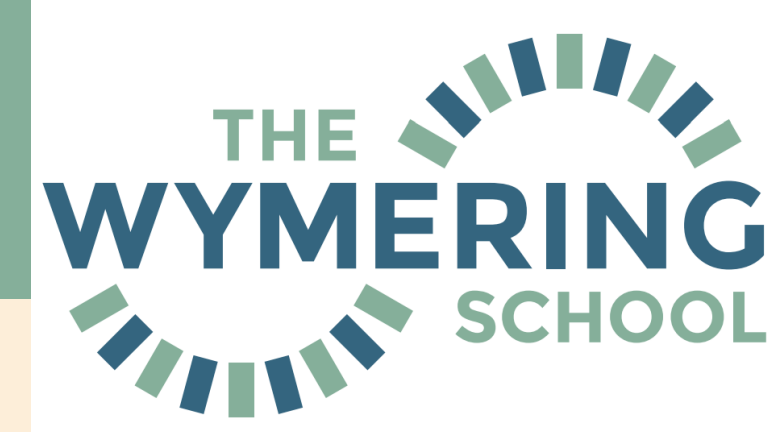




Learning in KS3 this half term

Theme: Growing

Subject	Learning Objective
English	I can apply spelling rules and phonics patterns consistently. I can use a dictionary and thesaurus effectively. I can use the first, second and third place letters to sequence words in alphabetical order. I can follow and understand discussions and make relevant contributions in a variety of contexts .
Maths	I can use place value to work with numbers up to 10,000. I can multiply and divide using times tables facts and written methods. I can use fractions such as $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{10}$ in calculations. I can use fractions, decimals and percentages to describe amounts.
PSHE	I can build and maintain positive relationships. I can understand and cope with changes in relationships and I know where to access help and support when needed. I can recognise the impact of my behaviour on others, respect different viewpoints, debate constructively, and understand the importance of tolerance in a diverse society.
